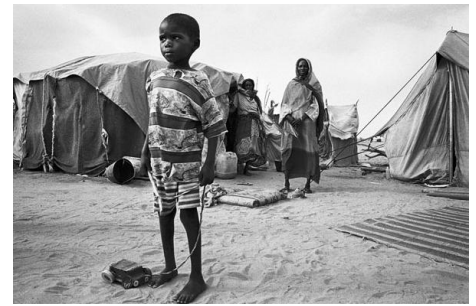




Afternoon of Awareness: Darfur Genocide
